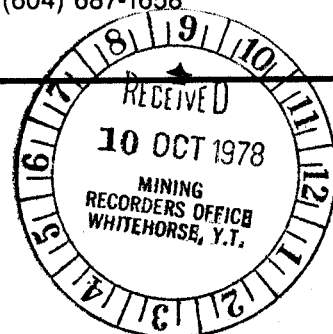

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INTRODUCTION

Welcome North Mines Ltd., as Operator of the Woodside Joint Venture Programme with Getty Mining Pacific Ltd., optioned the AL, KIRK, and RIM claims, a group of 12 mineral claims, in 1977, and carried out geological, geophysical and geochemical surveys in 1977 (see "Report on the Geological, Geochemical and Geophysical Surveys and Diamond Drilling and Trenching on the MONI, PMJ, JANE, TELE, KIRK, AL, RIM, EEL and ANGIE Mineral Claims by Graham Scott, May 26, 1978). In July and August of 1978 further linecutting was carried out over the AL, KIRK and RIM claims in preparation for further geophysical and geochemical surveys.

MINERAL CLAIMS

The work being filed under this report covers the following claims in N.T.S. 105K-3 (Fig. 1):

LOCATION AND ACCESS

The AL, KIRK and RIM claims are located in the St. Cyr Range of the southern Yukon, N.T.S. 105K-3. The claims are situated on a ridge top about 25 kilometers southeast of Faro and 7 kilometers from the Robert Campbell Highway. Access to the property can be gained by way of an old cat road connected with the Robert Campbell Highway, or by helicopter from Faro or Ross River.

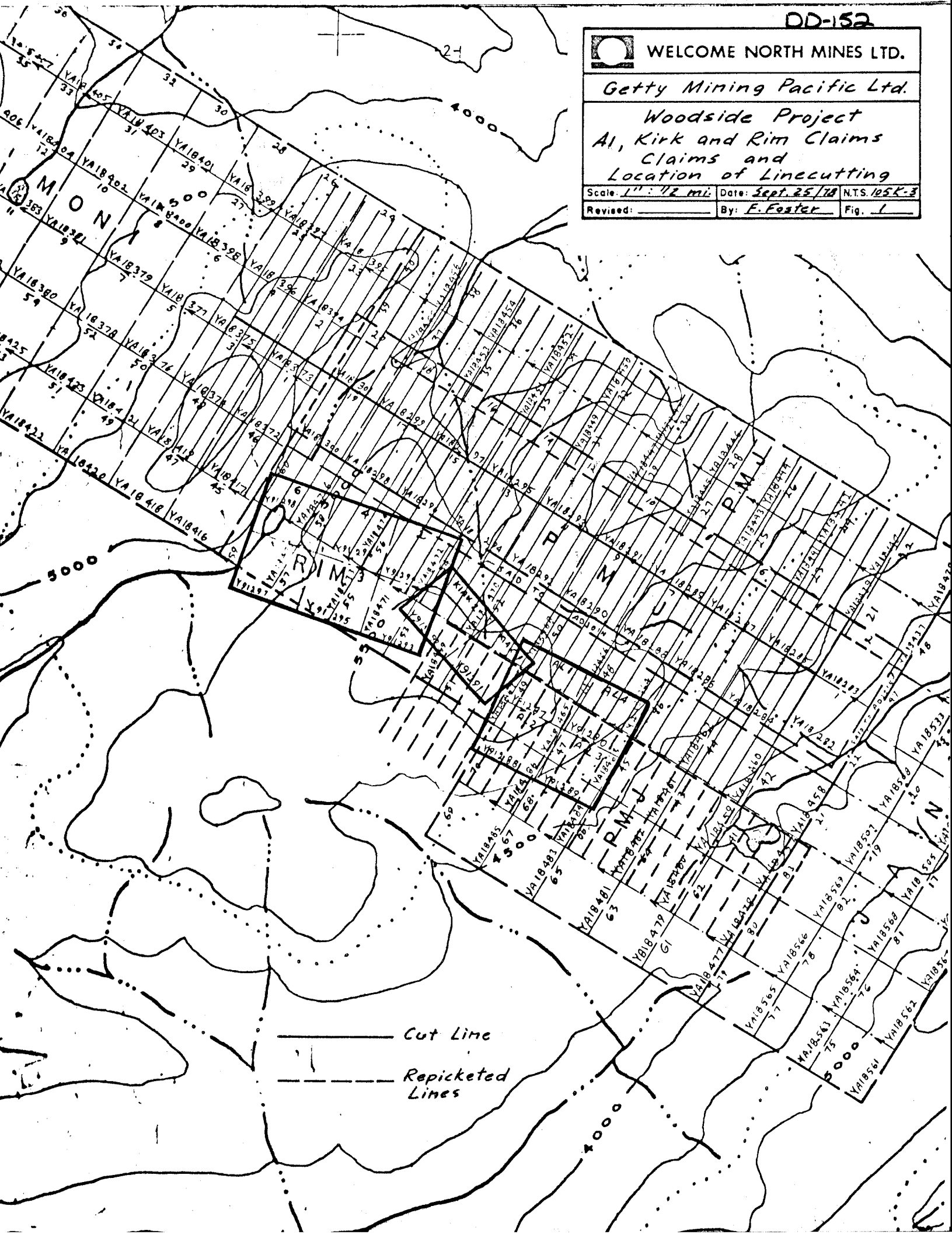

LINECUTTING

Linecutting carried out on the claims consisted of installing new cutline grid and repicketing in slope-corrected metric last year's lines in preparation for geophysical surveys and geochemical surveys. A tieline was installed along the southwestern boundary of the 1977 grid and these previous lines were extended by 900m to the southeast. Pickets were spaced 50m apart, and where new lines were installed in the extreme southeast of the grid the line spacing was 150m (Fig. 1).

Helicopter support was supplied by Bell 47G3B model at a rate of \$175/hour and by Hughes 500D model at a rate of \$315/hour.
