

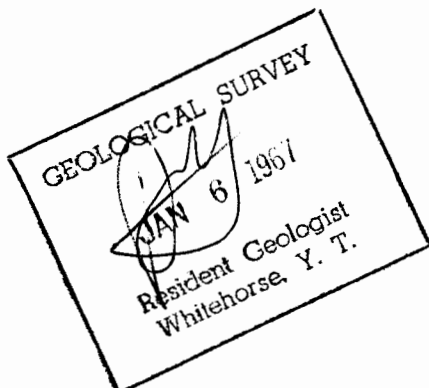

LETTER OF TRANSMITTAL

Direct exploration and development expenditure by Casino Silver Mines Limited on their Casino and Canadian Creek property during the first eleven months of the fiscal year which ends November 30th, 1966, amounts to \$231,053.12 as follows:

The attached applications to record assessment work on 88 claims to a common anniversary date of October 2nd, 1968, require a minimum work expenditure of \$25,600.00. The actual expenditure on the claims, as covered by this report on geophysical surveys, amounts to a proportion of items, 1, 2, and 3, above, or \$46,383.99. This expenditure is distributed as follows:

The geophysical survey work was accomplished under my direction by Cana Exploration Consultants Limited of Suite 427, 12 Richmond Street East, Toronto 1, Ontario. A Sharpe A-2 Magnetometer was used for the ground magnetic surveys and was operated by Gaston Heyerdahl. A Sharpe SE-200 instrument was used for the electro-magnetic surveys and was operated by Joseph Kakish assisted by B. Hawes. The check electro-magnetic surveys were run with a Ronka EM-16 instrument operated by Joseph Kakish. The operators are all care of the above address.

The field examination work, the interpretation of geological data and the geophysical reporting was done by Dr. S. S. Ssetu, of Cana Exploration Consultants Limited. Dr. Ssetu is a Geologist and a Geophysicist of excellent reputation. His certificate is included in his report on the Silver Lead Property of Casino Silver Mines Ltd.

The attached reports are as follows:

Section I. "H" Anomaly Area, represents claims Joe 65 to 72 and Joe 81 to 88 inclusive as per the attached locational plan. This is an area of difficult access requiring the use of the Helicopter. A stand of dense second-growth Spruce over the area raised line-cutting costs.

Section II. Central Part of Property, represents claims Vic 9 to 32 and Vic 41 to 48 in three groupings as per the attached locational plan. Also attached are the Diamond Drill logs for the two holes drilled as follow-up work to the geophysical survey and a commentary by Dr. Ssetu on the results of the diamond drilling.

Section III. Canadian Creek Part of Property, represents claims

Cat 47 to 70 in two groupings as per the attached locational plan. This involved two geophysical surveys and two sets of picket lines; a preliminary survey to define the structural attitude of the rock beneath this heavily overburdened area, and a final survey oriented vertical to the conductive zones to obtain depth characteristics. The line-cutting costs are comparatively low due to low brush cover and a total lack of trees.

Section IV. "C" Anomaly Area, represents claims Joe 17 to 32 inclusive

as per the attached locational plan. This area also required a preliminary geophysical survey in order to orient the final survey so that the picket lines would be vertical to the conductive zones which were entirely covered by overburden. The final baseline was cut from the central portion of the Joe 17 to 32 group of claims, north-westerly for 10,000 feet to the Cat claims. The geophysical survey was not completed by the end of the season. Conductive zones were mapped on the Cat claims and these zones are open to the south-east toward the Joe claims, as evidenced by subsequent trenching.

Section V. Report on the Silver Lead Property of Casino Creek Area.

This is an informational report on the area covered by all the above claim groups. It contains a locational map and a certificate pertaining to Dr. S. S. Sætu.

A bibliographical reference to the available published geology of the Casino and Canadian Creek Districts is attached.

Also attached is a Certificate and Affidavit of Expenditure by the Company on their property between May 15th and October 31st, 1966. These expenditures are supported by statements and vouchers, photostats of which are appended hereto.

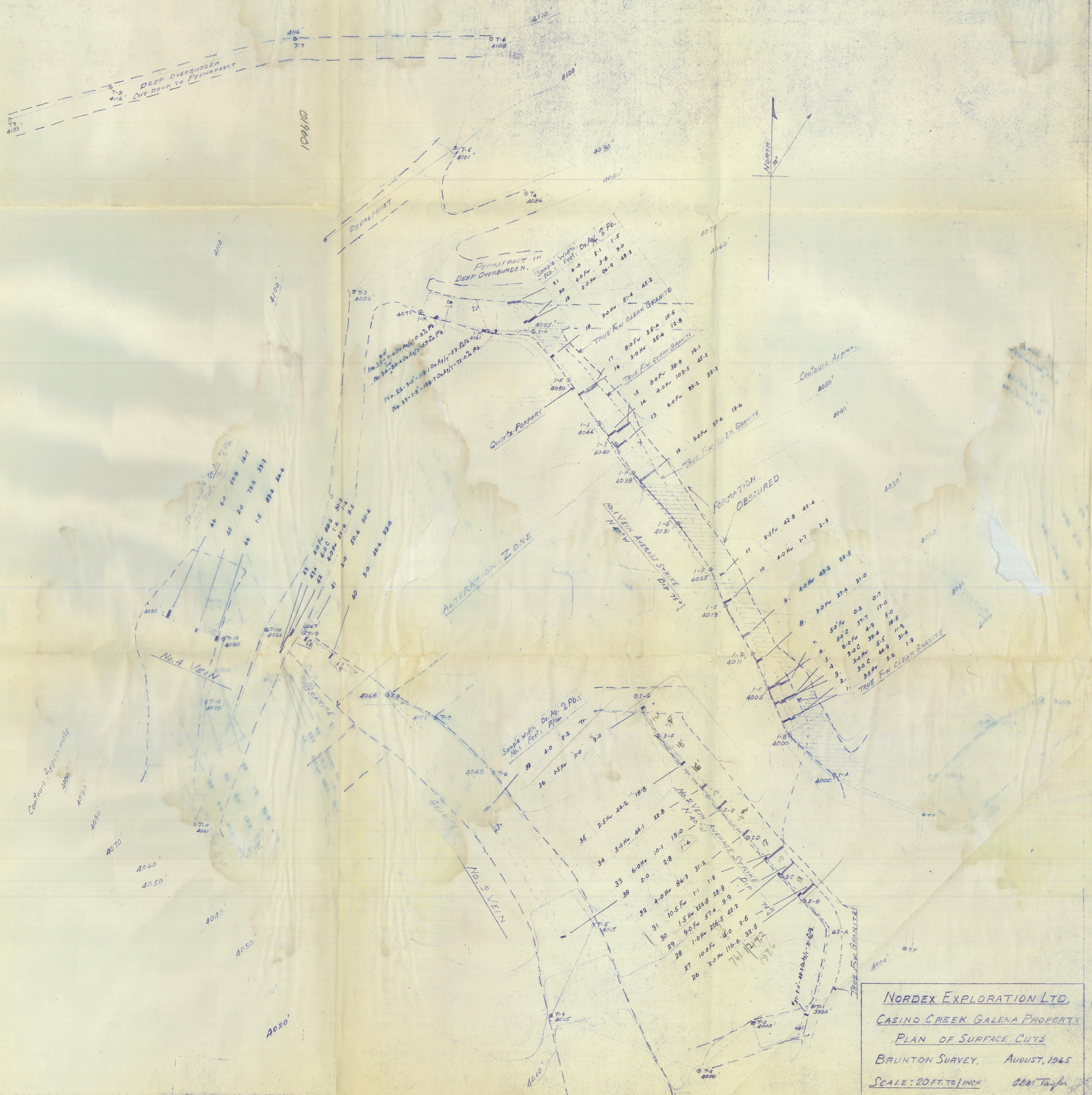

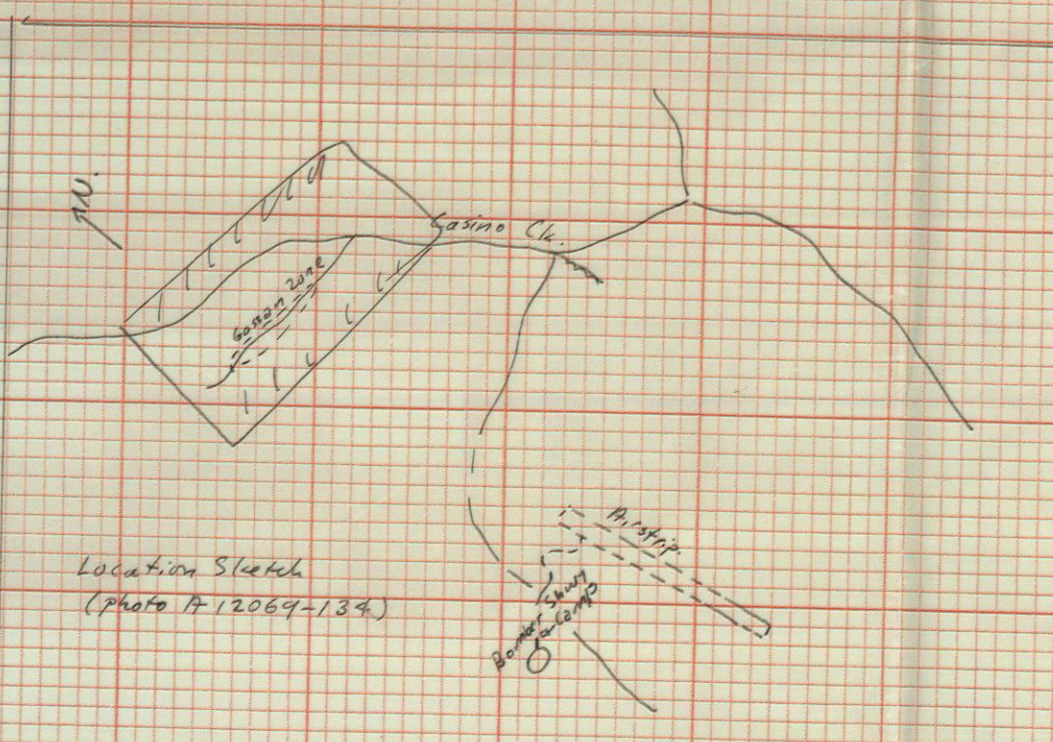
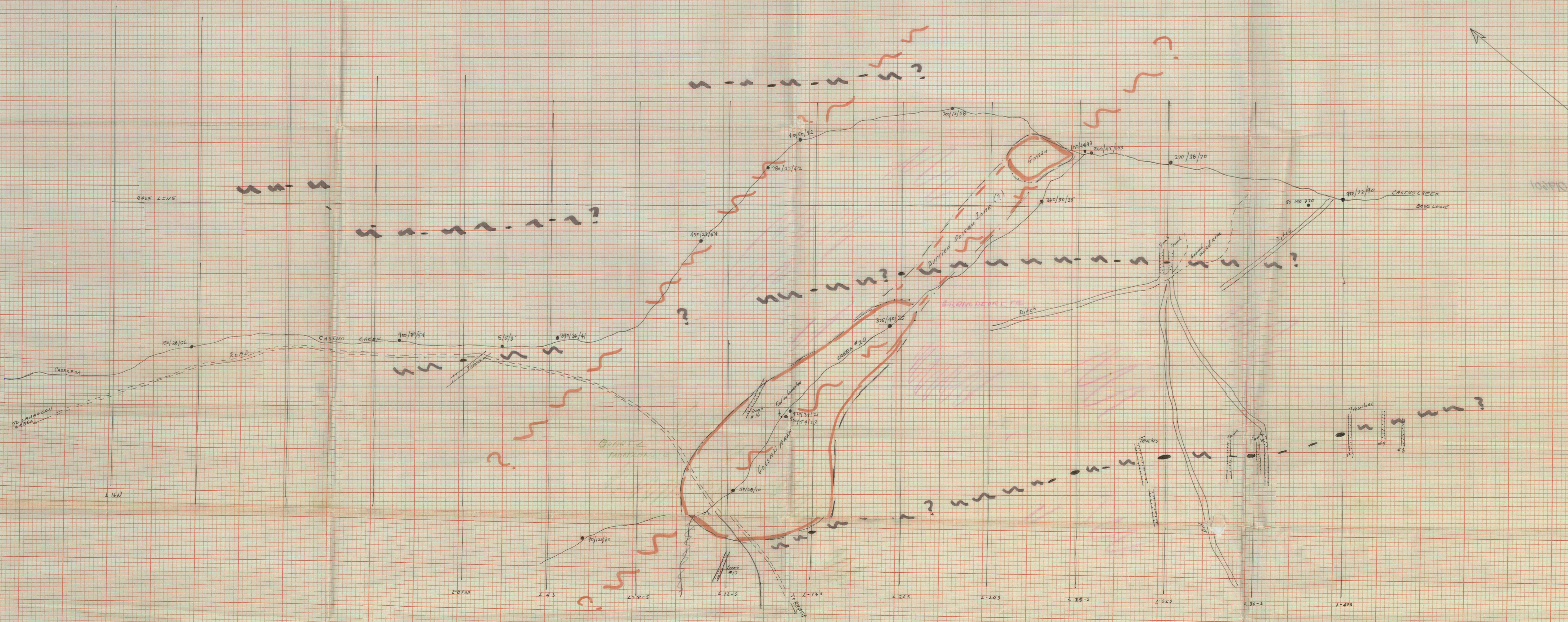
