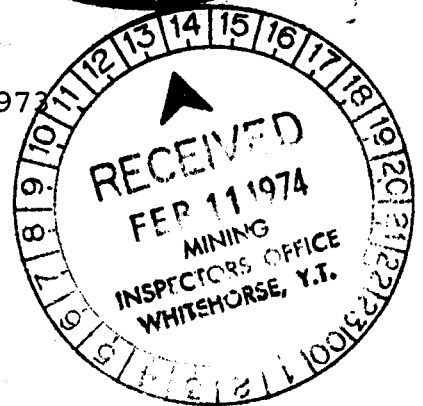


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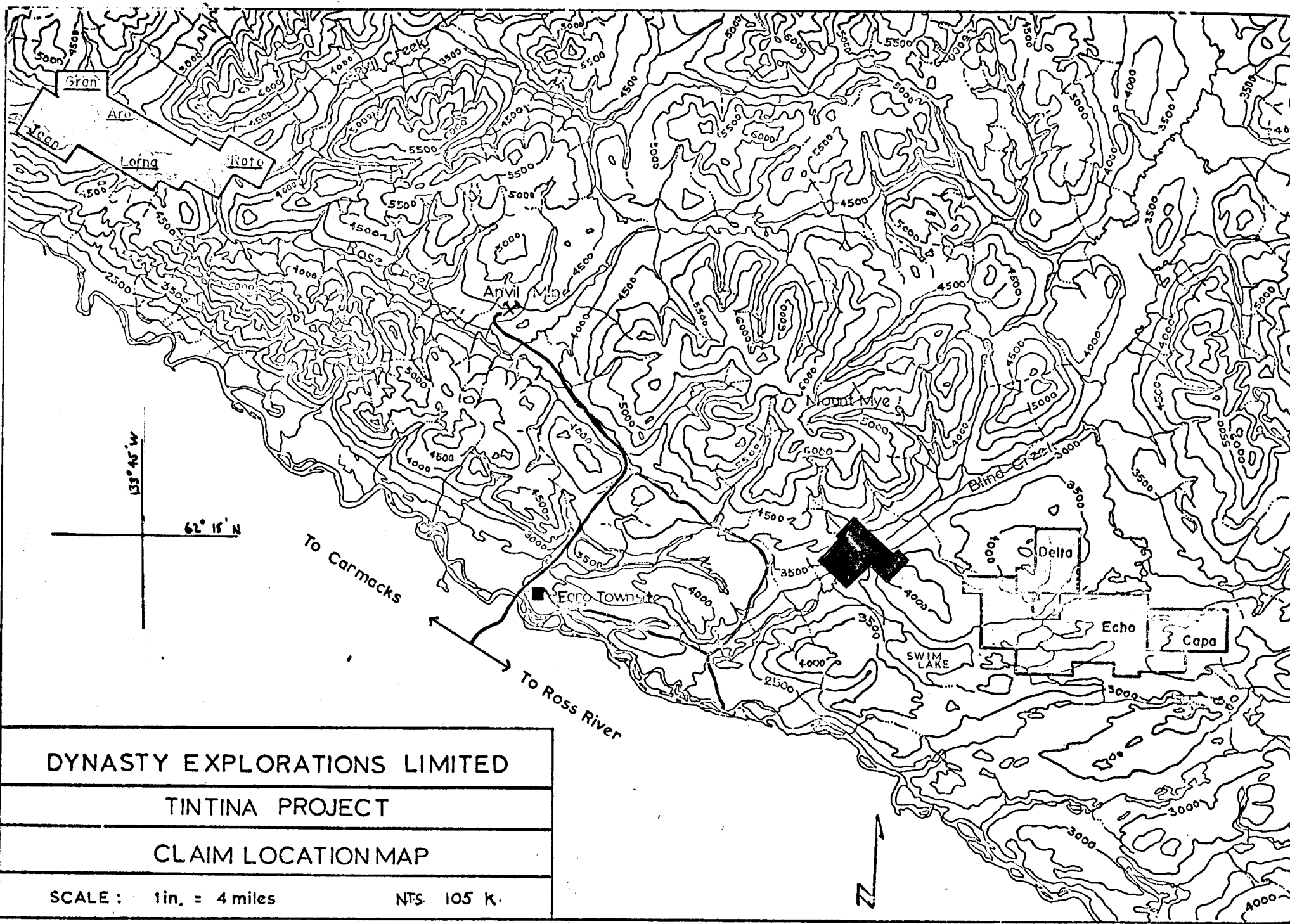

INTRODUCTION

The area covered by the Hoho-Bram Mineral Claims was originally staked in 1964 as part of the DY claims. These claims lapsed and were restaked in 1966 as the Luk Group. These claims also lapsed and were finally restaked in 1971 by Dynasty Explorations as the Hoho-Bram mineral claims.

Prior to the 1971 field season, the only work done on the property consisted of airborne magnetic and electromagnetic surveys completed in 1964 and 1965 by Dynasty Explorations. These airborne surveys defined a number of magnetic and electromagnetic anomalies within the claim group area.

During the 1971 field season, detailed geologic mapping was carried out on the property. A number of minor sulphide occurrences were discovered at this time consisting of minor sphalerite and galena in quartz veins, and minor pyrrhotite and chalcopyrite in greenstone lenses. Soil samples were collected on grid lines in proximity to the airborne anomalies. Also, during the 1971 program, a "C.E.M." horizontal loop electromagnetic survey was completed over the entire claim group.

The results of the 1971 project are described in detail in the report titled "Geologic, Geochemical and Geophysical Investigations Hoho-Bram Mineral Claims", by P. Dean and J. S. Brock, August, 1971.

Work on the Hoho-Bram claims during the 1973 field season, described in this report, consists of linecutting, a ground magnetometer survey and a Turam electromagnetic survey. All work was done on the portion of the claim group that lies to the west of Blind Creek. The deep penetrating Turam technique was used to give better definition to the known airborne and ground E.M. targets, and the ground magnetic survey would verify the location of and detail the airborne magnetic survey results.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

The Hoho-Bram claim group is located at about longitude $133^{\circ}00'$ W. and latitude $62^{\circ}18'$ N., on map sheet 105-K-3. The claims straddle Blind Creek, about seven miles upstream from its confluence with the Pelly River. The town of Faro is located about 10 miles southwest of the property.

A "cat road" along the northwest side of the Blind Creek valley passes through the Hoho-Bram claims, about $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles from this roads junction with the Vangorda road. This "cat road" is suitable only for a bombardier or other tracked vehicle. During the 1973 field work, a helicopter that was based in Faro was used to provide access to the property.

LINECUTTING

During the 1973 field work, 9.8 miles of cut picket line were added to the existing grid on the Hoho claims. This linecutting was contracted to Martinson Linecutting and Staking Ltd., of Powell River, B.C. This additional grid line gave better coverage in the areas of the known geophysical anomalies and also provided cut "loops" for the Turam survey coil lay-out.

TURAM ELECTROMAGNETIC SURVEY

The Turam electromagnetic survey was contracted to Scintrex Surveys Limited. of Vancouver, B.C. A total of 12.4 line miles were covered by this survey. The complete text of their report is included on the following pages. The Scintrex map of the Turam survey results is found in Appendix IV (Figure 1).

INTRODUCTION

During the period August 2nd - 14th, 1973, Turam electromagnetic surveys were executed on behalf of Dynasty Explorations Ltd., by Scintrex Surveys Limited.

The claim group covered is Hoho. The survey area is located three miles northwest of Swim Lake and approximately 10 miles due east of the Faro town site, (see Fig. 2). The area is rugged and is located between 3500' and 4000' a.s.l.

The geophysical survey party was under the direction of Mr. Tony Geurnier with overall supervision of Mr. Michael Lewis, M.Sc., P.Eng. The survey was executed out of a campsite established on the grid.

The grid comprised of N135°E running baselines and 9 lines varying in length from 3400'-9000' at 800' interval and perpendicular to the baselines. A total of 12.4 line miles were covered.

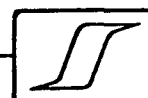
Five energizing loops were laid out. The purpose of the survey was to locate and map any subsurface sulphide mineralization. The area has high potential with the Faro ore bodies located 12 miles to the NW.

EQUIPMENT AND METHOD

During the present survey a Scintrex SE-71 three frequency Turam-electromagnetic unit was employed. The basic energization frequency was 400 Hz with some details executed with 800 Hz.

The basic energization loop size was 3200' x 3000', however, some smaller or larger loops were used (see Plate 3). The separation between the receiver coils was 100'.

The enclosed specification sheet, Appendix T, and article entitled "Some Aspects of the Turam Electromagnetic Method" give further details on the equipment and technique.



PRESENTATION OF DATA

Plate 3 on a horizontal scale of 1"=400' shows the electromagnetic results in profile form. Vertical scales used are 1"=20% FSR and 1"=10° phase.

DISCUSSION OF RESULTS

The Turam electromagnetic results reveal a moderate distortion pattern over most parts of the grid. Background levels of 6% FSR and 2-3° phase difference are common. The distortion pattern increases further away from the loop which suggests a rather homogenous overburden or weathering conduction. The possibility of sequences of small banded zones of conductive materials such as sulphides (in uneconomic quantity) or graphites can cause a similar pattern.

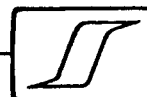
Some weak zones most likely without economic significance have been indicated on Plate 3. Two banded zones marked A¹-A³ and B¹ and B₂ might be of interest.

Zone A1-A3 is centered around Line 24W station 28S and consists of at least four more or less parallel bands. The conductivity x width and depth to the target are due to the influence of the "environmental" conductivity (overburden or weathering) difficult to estimate. But these figures should be in the range of 3 mhos or 100 feet subsurface respectively. The zone is not clearly identified on the south side. To get better qualitative and quantitative information a loop should be placed closer to this complex zone. The amplitudes of FSR and phase difference will then be smaller and conductivity x width might be higher making the zone more attractive.

Zone B1-B2 centered on line O station 56S is open to the southeast and south. Similar remarks as made for zone A1-A3 are applicable for this zone.

CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

A Turam electromagnetic survey executed over a grid in the Swim Lake Faro region, Yukon Territory reveals large areas of moderate electromagnetic distortions. These distortions are most likely related to overburden/ weathering or banded horizons containing carbonaceous and graphite rich lenses. The possibility of sulphides being present is not excluded and some zones marked A1-B2 are of potential interest.

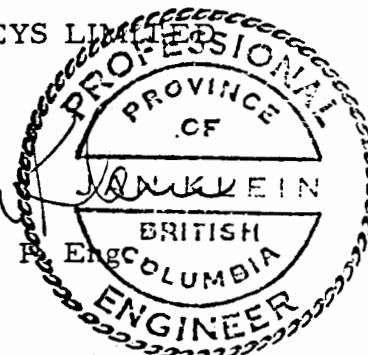


Before recommending diamond drilling on any of these zones it is recommended to correlate each one of the zones with the geological and/or geochemical data available so that the most interesting targets can be selected.

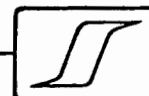

GROUND MAGNETIC SURVEY

A total of 8.5 line miles of ground magnetometer survey was completed. For this survey, a Sharpe MF-1 magnetometer was used. This is a hand-held, direct reading, oil damped, fluxgate magnetometer which measures the vertical magnetic component.

Readings were taken at 100 ft. stations on the grid lines. Readings were corrected for diurnal drift. Values in gammas were plotted on a 1"= 400 ft. grid base map which was then contoured at 50 gamma intervals.

Because of a crew scheduling problem, and difficulty in obtaining a magnetometer when it was required, the magnetic survey was only 75% completed.

The grid area has a magnetic background level of about 520 gammas.

A magnetic "high" was defined in the northeast corner of the grid area (peak value of 750 gammas). The location of the ground magnetic anomaly correlated very well with the location of the aeromagnetic anomaly that was obtained in this area (see Figure 2).

Ground survey coverage is incomplete in the area of the northwest aeromagnetic anomaly, although its presence is indicated by the gradual build-up in ground survey gamma values on lines 40W and 49W, just south of the base line.

Although ground survey coverage is again incomplete, the "open" mag high (peak 620 gammas) on line 24W, 30-32S, verifies the small aeromagnetic "high" in this same area.

DISCUSSION OF GEOPHYSICAL RESULTS

The two large magnetic anomalies located north of base line "0" do not have any coincident anomalous Turam responses associated with them. The moderate background Turam distortion pattern in this area "suggests a rather homogeneous overburden or weathering conduction". There is no outcrop in the vicinity of these magnetic anomalies. It is thought that they reflect "greenstone" lenses within phyllite, as are seen in outcrop in the same stratigraphic section in the southwest margin and southwest of the grid area.

Turam zone B₁-B₂ at the southeast corner of the grid is coincident with a C.E.M. conductor. These conductors have a low apparent conductivity. The profiles suggest that the conductors are a number of thin parallel conductive bands, possibly containing minor sulphides or graphite. There are no anomalous magnetic responses associated with these electromagnetic anomalies. There is no outcrop in this area.

Turam zone A₁-A₂-A₃ is a number of near-surface, low conductivity responses the cause of which is at least four or more thin conductive parallel horizons. The reliability of the data in this area is somewhat suspect because of the distance away from the E.M. loop. The "open" magnetic "high" is probably a reflection of the greenstone lens that outcrops just north of base line 30S, between lines 16W and 24W. However, the broader, lower magnitude magnetic zone within the 550 gamma contour encloses the anomalous Turam responses and also is within the larger C.E.M. zone.

The greenstone lens, between line 16W and line 24W contains minor disseminated chalcopyrite and is probably the source of the anomalous copper values in soils detected in this area. Phyllite outcrop areas at about 23S, scattered between lines 16W and 32W, on the north flank of the anomalous Turam zone, are somewhat graphitic.

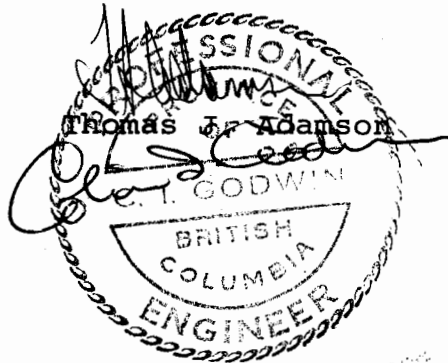
CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

On the Hoho-Bram claims only the area of the Turam A1-A2-A3 zone warrants any further attention. Although there are plausible explanations for the Turam anomaly (graphitic phyllite) and the magnetic anomaly ("greenstone"), these explanations are not conclusive and the responses could be the result of underlying sulphide mineralization. This zone is favourably located in the graphitic quartz phyllite unit in close proximity to the "Swim" conductors.

For a low priority follow-up program, it is suggested that a small gravity survey be carried out in the area of interest, although the interpretation of the gravity results will be complicated by the presence of greenstone lenses and by variable overburden thickness.

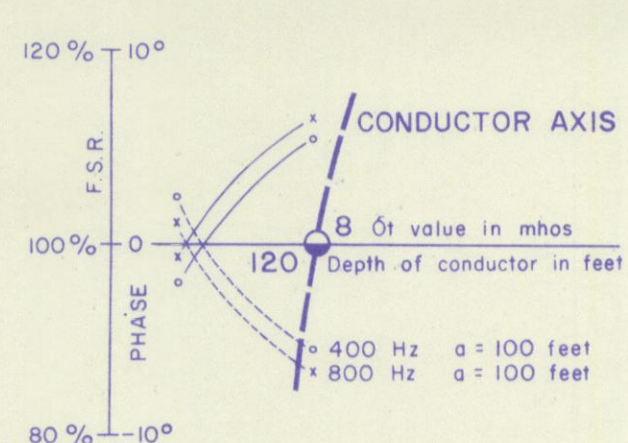

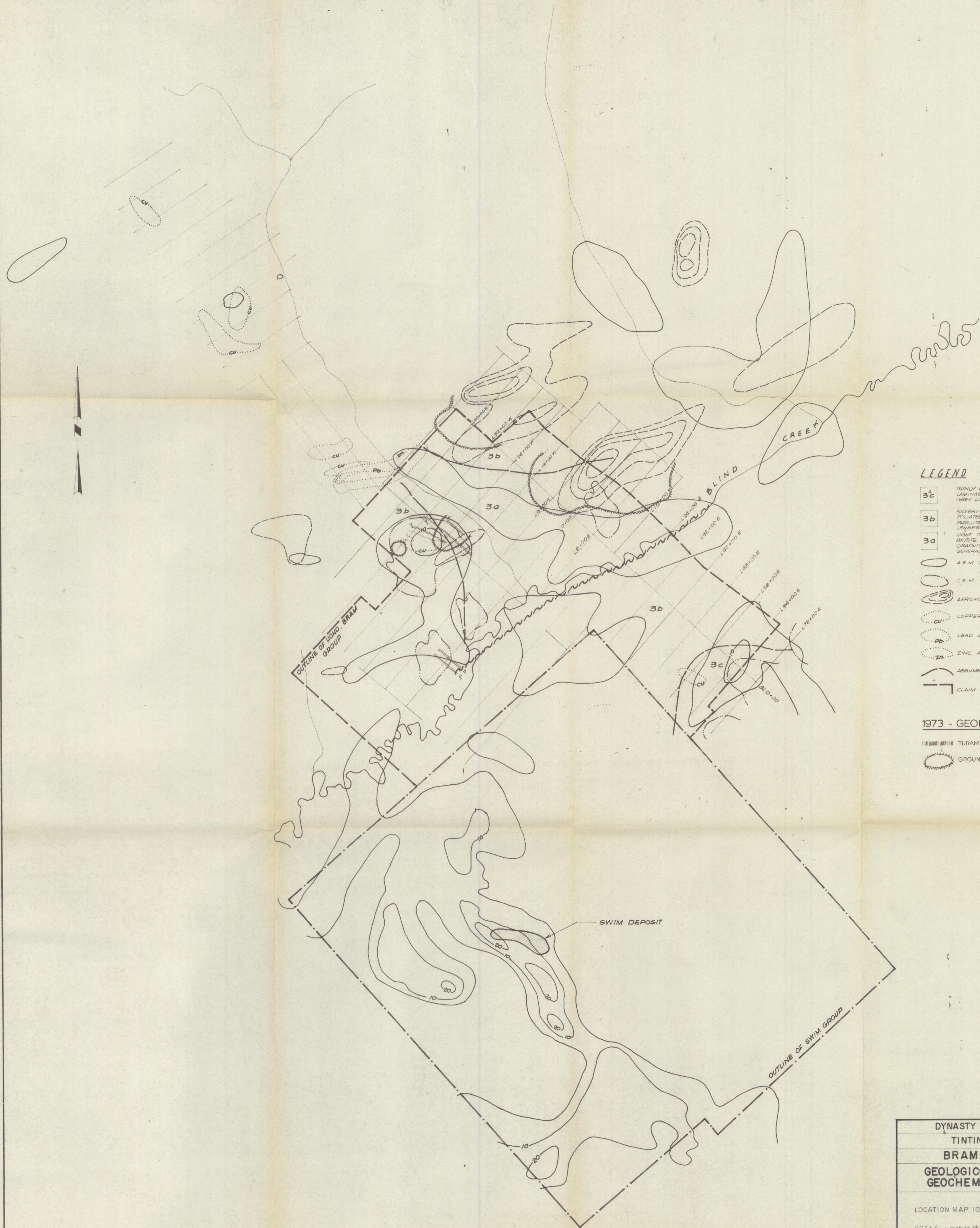
