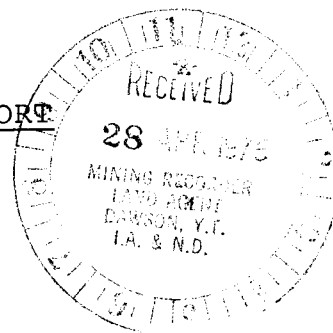

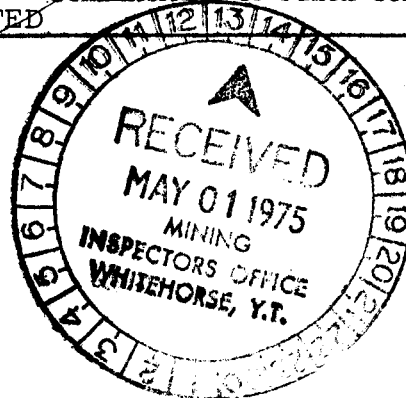

GEOCHEMICAL AND GEOLOGICAL REPORT 1974 FIELD WORK RALPH CLAIM GROUP

INTRODUCTION

The Ralph Group was staked in August of 1974 to cover a lead and zinc silt geochemical anomaly discovered earlier in the 1974 field season, following preliminary prospecting. Work on the property consisted of detailed prospecting, geochemistry and hand trenching, with assays and rock geochemistry of samples from the hand trench.

CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The size of the outcropping of mineralization on the Ralph group, as indicated by geochemistry, gossanous float trains and physiographic limitations, is not sufficient to merit drilling. Initial assay values are not encouraging, nor are the results of soil geochemistry. However, the massive nature of the secondary mineralization indicates that further hand trenching to expose primary sulphides may be advisable.

LOCATION AND ACCESS (See Figure 1)

The Ralph Group is located on the southwest bank of the Ogilvie River near longitude $138^{\circ}17'W.$ and latitude $64^{\circ}51'N.$, approximately ten miles southwest of Ogilvie Crossing, in the Ogilvie Mountains of west-central Yukon. Access to the property is by helicopter, with vehicle support from the Dempster Highway, five miles to the east.

GEOLOGY

The rocks of the Ralph claim group are grey, blocky fracturing, massive siliceous dolomites. This unit is believed to be Lower to Middle Ordovician in age, as they are conformably overlain to the south by thinly bedded cherts, graptolitic shales and shaly limestones which have been correlated with the Ordovician and Silurian Road River Formation.

Mineralization appears to be primarily secondary iron, zinc and lead minerals. A hand trench was dug in September of 1974 across the zone of most intense gossanous sub-outcroppings (See Figure 3). The trench, 20 feet long, approximately three feet wide and averaging three feet in depth, reached bedrock or in-place rubble for its full length. Approximately 80% of the floor of the trench was composed of massive slabs of secondary minerals, principally limonite. Two 10 ft. continuous rock chip samples from the trench floor were taken for assay: Metal values for the northeast sample (assay number 1985) were 0.09% Pb and 3.18% Zn; Values for the southwest sample (assay number 1986) were 0.06% Pb and 2.74% Zn. Five grab samples from the trench analyzed geochemically averaged 1.25% Zn with trace amounts of lead. All analyses were by Acme Analytical Laboratories Ltd., 6455 Laurel St., Burnaby, B.C.

GEOCHEMISTRY (See Figure 4)

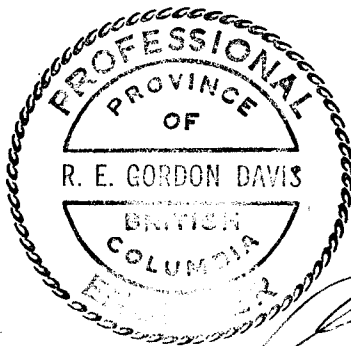
A total of 42 soil samples were taken parallel to the strike of the ridge, on the zone of gossanous float (See Figure 4). Because of the small number of samples involved, no statistical interpretation of metal values was attempted. Lead values ranged from 46 ppm to 18,500 ppm. Zinc values ranged from 60 ppm to 14,800 ppm. All analyses were by Acme Analytical Laboratories Ltd.

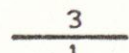

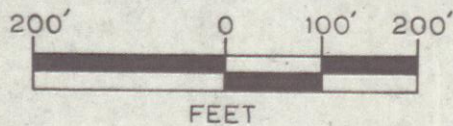
