

## Brewis at Work On Yukon Group

Brewis Red Lake Mines has started exploration on the company's group of claims in the Keno Hill district adjoining United Keno Hill Mines.

Drifting has started in the exploration tunnel on the main vein. It is proposed to drive this tunnel from 500 to 1,000 feet north-easterly above the vein to investigate the high-grade silver-lead ore which was located in prospecting work.

All necessary equipment and supplies are now on the property and camps have been erected.


