INTRODUCTION

The GRIZZLY claims were staked in April, May, and August, 1981 near the headwaters of Slate Creek to cover a possible south-westerly extension of the Red Mountain porphyry molybdenum deposit.

The area is underlain by slates, schists, quartzites, and related gneisses of the Big Salmon Complex of Precambrian to Mississippian age. Quartz-feldspar porphyry stocks of late Cretaceous to Tertiary age intrude the area.

The work described in this report was done between August 24 and September 3, 1981.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

The GRIZZLY claims are located in the Sawtooth Range just northeast of the Teslin River, 75 km east-northeast of Whitehorse (see Plate 1a). The claims are located in mountainous terrain around tree-line between elevations of 1200 and 1750 m. Access is by helicopter based in Whitehorse.

## GEOLOGY AND MINERALIZATION

The claims are located near the eastern edge of the Whitehorse Trough. The area is underlain by rocks of the Big Salmon Complex and by more recent intrusives. In this area the Complex consists of slates, schists, quartzites and related gneisses of Precambrian to Mississippian age. The intrusives are quartz-feldspar porphyry stocks of late Cretaceous to Tertiary age.

No mineralization has been located on the property. Potential exists for a southwesterly extension of the Red Mountain porphyry molybdenum deposit or for a separate mineralized system.

## GEOCHEMISTRY

### Sample Collection

A total of 69 soil samples were collected at 100 m intervals along the 4000', 4500, and 5000' contours. The samples were taken at a depth of 10 - 20 cm from the "C" soil horizon where possible. Sample recovery was 93%.

A total of 14 stream silt samples were taken from creeks running through the property.

### Sample Preparation

All soil and silt samples were dried and sieved to -80 mesh. Cu, Pb, Zn, and Mo analyses were performed by Atomic Absorption after digestion in acid. The analyses were conducted by Bondar-Clegg at their Whitehorse laboratory under the supervision of Mr. Steve Simpson.

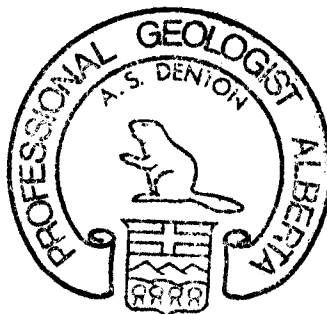
### Interpretation of Results

The results of the geochemical survey are plotted on Plate 2. Slightly anomalous molybdenum values occur on the 4000' and 4500' contour lines in the northern part of the property. High copper values do not appear to coincide with this anomaly and are scattered irregularly. Anomalous zinc and some high lead values coincide with the molybdenum anomaly and warrant further investigation. Anomalous values of these three elements occur almost exclusively to the northeast of the creek (see Plate 2).

Anomalous silt samples appear to be restricted to locations in the northern part of the claim group and corroborate the Zn-Pb-Mo soil anomaly.

## CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This soil and silt sampling program has identified a small Zn-Pb-Mo anomaly in the northern portion of the claim block. More detailed sampling and geological mapping is recommended for further evaluation of these claims.

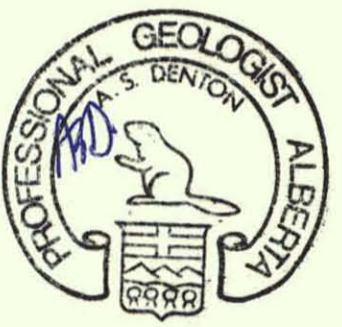




CLAIM GROUP BOUNDARY
