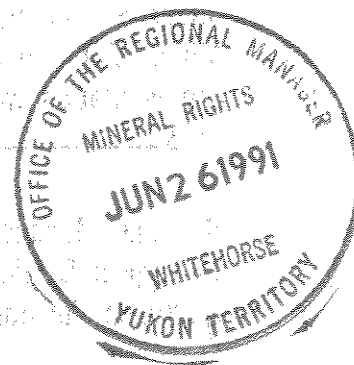

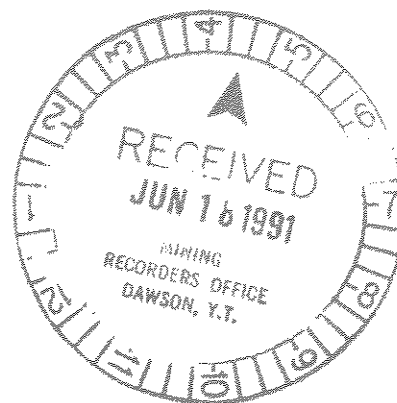

INTRODUCTION

The Pub property was staked in June, 1990 by YGC Resources Ltd. The claims were acquired to cover previously outlined lead-zinc-silver geochemical anomalies associated with stratabound volcanogenic sphalerite-galena-pyrite mineralization.

The 1990 field program described in this report was funded by YGC and consisted of one sampling and prospecting trip to the property on September 7, 1990.

Appendix I includes the Author's Statement of Qualifications while a list of personnel who worked on the project is included as Appendix II.

PROPERTY, LOCATION AND ACCESS

The Pub property lies in west-central Yukon about 2 km north of the Top of the World Highway, 6 km east of the Alaska-Yukon border crossing and about 70 km west of Dawson City (Figure 1). Access for the 1990 field work was by foot from the highway.

The Pub property consists of six claims registered with the Dawson Mining Recorder in the name of Archer, Cathro as follows:

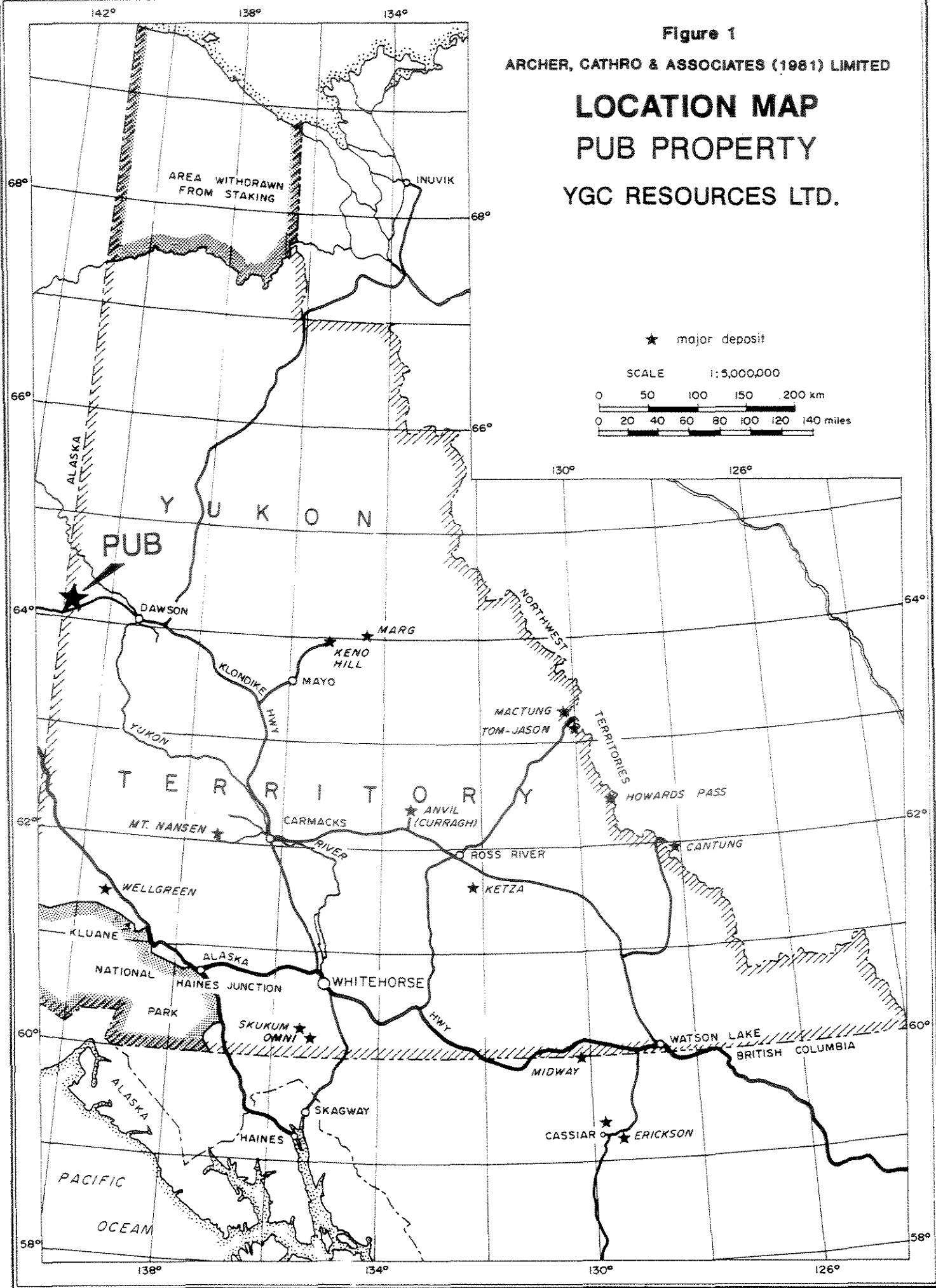

LOCATION MAP PUB PROPERTY YGC RESOURCES LTD.



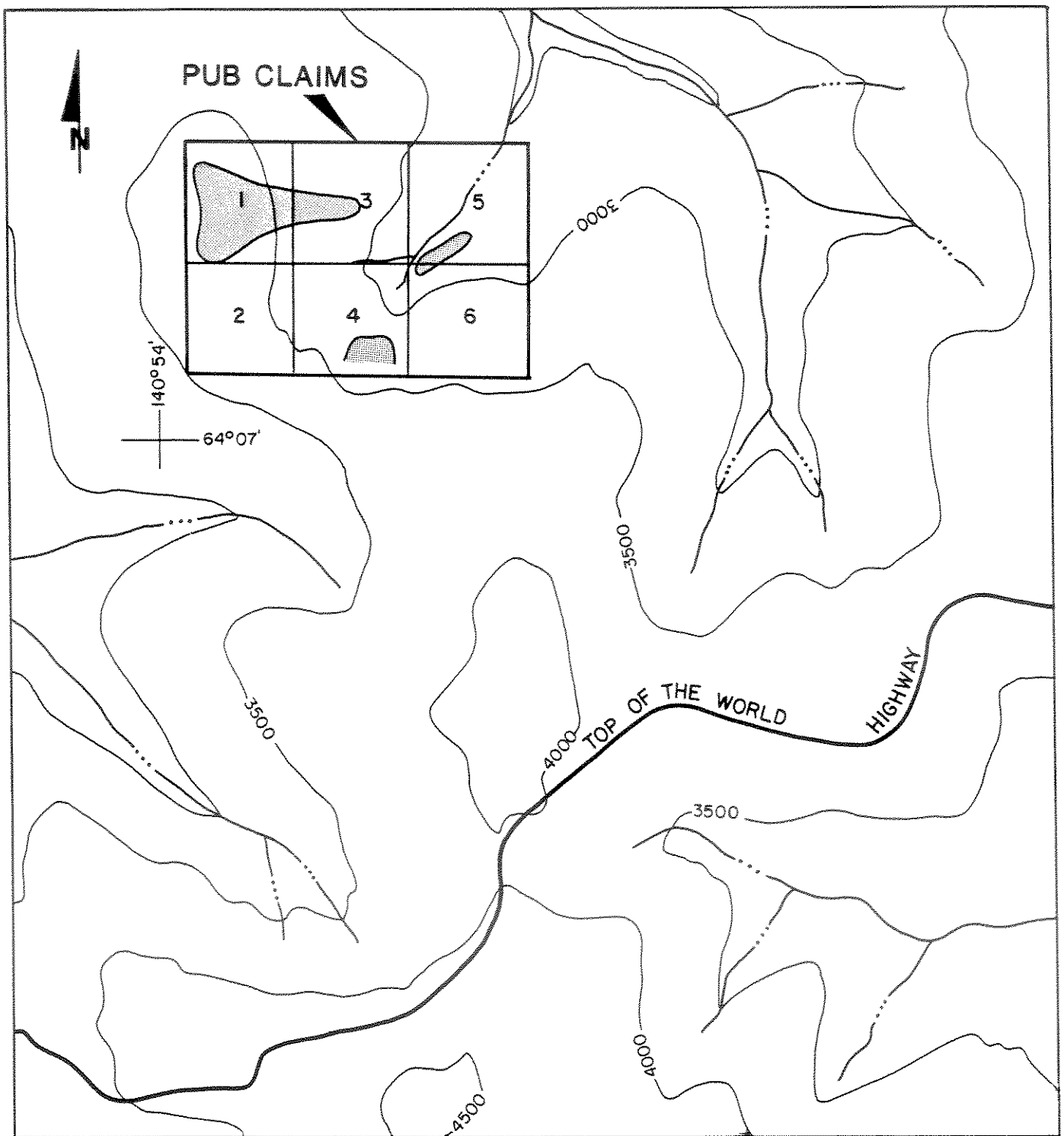

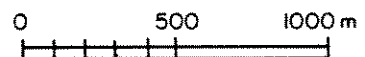

HISTORY AND PREVIOUS WORK

The area was originally staked and explored by Moose Creek Exploration Ltd. (later Ocean Home Exploration Co. Ltd.) which carried out prospecting, geological mapping and geochemical sampling in 1977 and 1978. YGC restaked the property in June, 1990.

GEOMORPHOLOGY

Topography on the Pub claims is subdued with elevations ranging from 790 to 1130 m. The area is lightly vegetated with scrub black spruce, willow and dwarf birch above a ground cover of grasses, sedges and low growing deciduous shrubs. Treeline is about 925 m elevation. Overburden cover is thin and spotty bedrock exposures are limited to a ridge crest along the west end of the property. Because the area is unglaciated, most of the property is mantled by soliflucted colluvium mixed with residual mineral soil that is capped by a thin layer of organic-rich soil and recent volcanic ash. Permafrost is probably relatively continuous.

GEOLOGY

The Pub claims are located within a northerly-dipping, 2000 m thick sequence of metavolcanic rocks informally named the Klondike Schist (Figure 3). Lithologies consist of pyritic quartz-muscovite schist, quartz and/or feldspar augen schist and chloritic schist with minor graphitic quartz-muscovite schist intervals. In general, there is a bimodal lithologic character with dominantly chloritic rocks at the structural base of the unit succeeded by mostly sericitic rocks toward the top. An Upper Permian zircon age date was determined by J.K. Mortensen of the GSC in 1990 from a sample of quartz-augen muscovite schist collected 2 km west of the property. Compositional layering dips about 25° to the northwest, parallel with bounding thrust faults that separate the Klondike Schist sequence from Devonian to Mississippian Nasina Series graphitic quartzite and quartz-muscovite schist. Erosional remnants of Late Cretaceous Carmacks Volcanics andesite flows with minor clastic sedimentary rocks unconformably overlie the metamorphic rocks at higher elevations east of the property.

MINERALIZATION

Disseminated sphalerite, galena and chalcopyrite with minor pyrite are reported to occur in siliceous schist at approximately the contact between chloritic and sericitic members of the Klondike Schist. The mineralization was discovered by Moose Creek in 1977 but the location is not reported.

The galena, sphalerite and chalcopyrite-bearing interval is similar to mineralization on the nearby Bal claims which is thought to be part of a metamorphosed volcanogenic exhalite deposit. Lead isotope analysis of galena from the Bal mineralization carried out by J.K. Mortensen yields a Middle to Upper Permian model age, concordant with age of the host rocks.

The Pub showing lies about 4 km northeast of, and along strike with, the Bal showing and the Boundary Prospect in Alaska. Little information is publicly available on the Boundary showing although it is known that the volcanogenic massive sulphide mineralization received extensive diamond drilling in the late 1970's. An impressive surface showing exposed along a north-facing dip slope was apparently not intersected at depth by the drilling.

GEOCHEMISTRY

Approximately 550 grid soil samples were collected from the Pub claims area by Moose Creek in 1977 and 1978. Two areas of anomalous multi-element geochemical response were outlined. Lead is the most anomalous element with many values in the 100 to 200 ppm range against a background of 10 to 25 ppm. Anomalous zinc values are in the range of 100 to 200 ppm with background values of 50 to 75 ppm. Anomalous copper values vary between 25 to 100 ppm against a background of 10 to 15 ppm. Silver values range up to 0.8 ppm against a background of 0.1 ppm. Lead values only are shown on Figure ~~2~~³ in the pocket.

The disseminated lead-zinc-copper mineralization reportedly discovered in 1977-78 was not relocated in 1990 but the anomalous areas outlined by the grid soil sampling lie along and downslope of the on-strike extrapolation of stratiform mineralization on the nearby Bal claims.

Limited soil sampling in 1990 returned background or only weakly anomalous values of lead, zinc, copper and silver. Sample locations are shown on Figure ~~2~~³ while analytical results are listed in Appendix II.


SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The six claim Pub property is located near road access in west-central Yukon Territory. The property was staked by YGC Resources Ltd. to cover previously outlined multi-element geochemical anomalies and stratiform lead-zinc-copper mineralization in metamorphosed Permian felsic ^{meta}volcanic rocks.

Additional exploration of the property should consist of relocation of the old geochemical grid to guide thorough prospecting and hand pitting of the most promising anomalies. This should be followed up with five to ten short diamond drill holes to evaluate the zone.

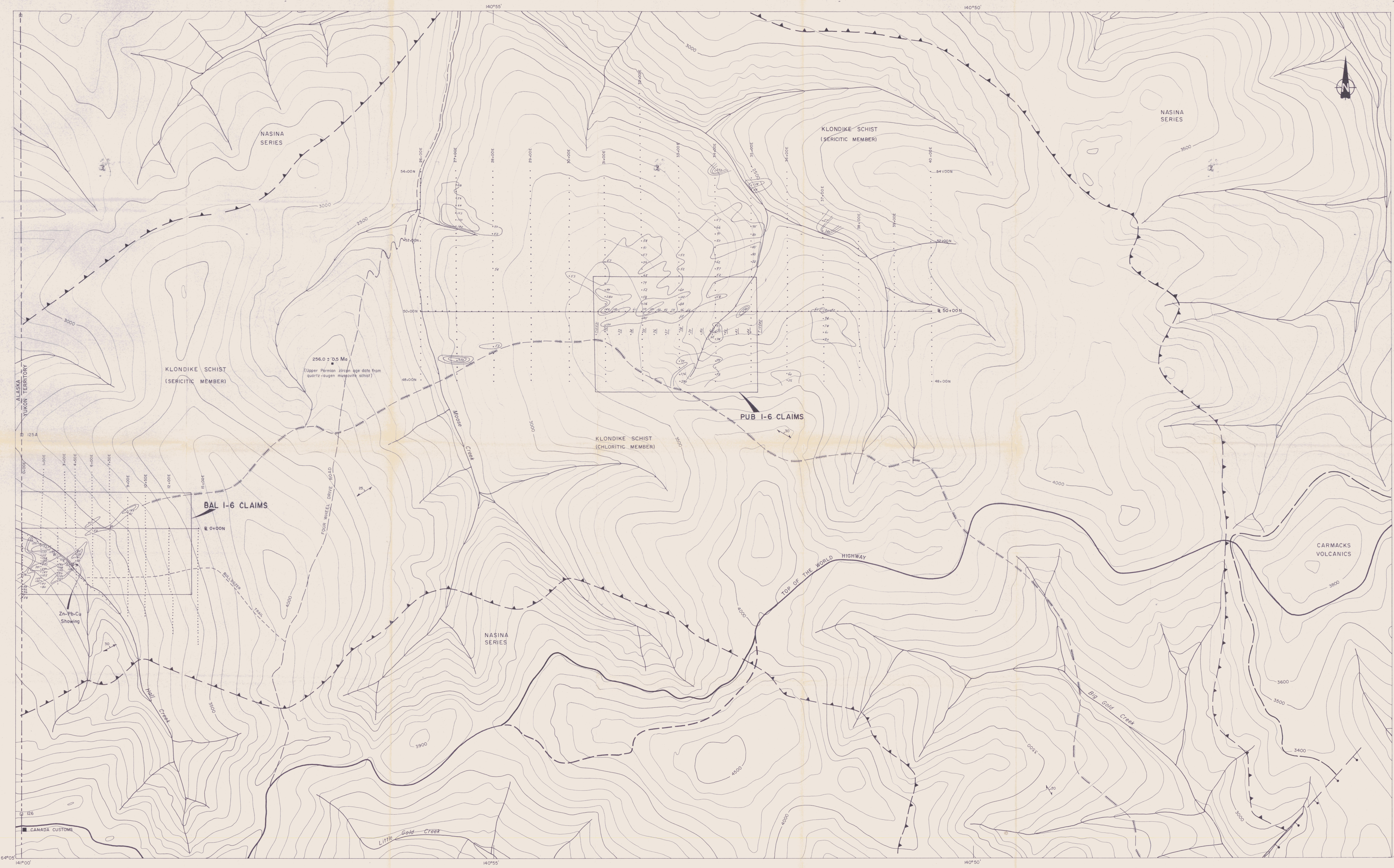

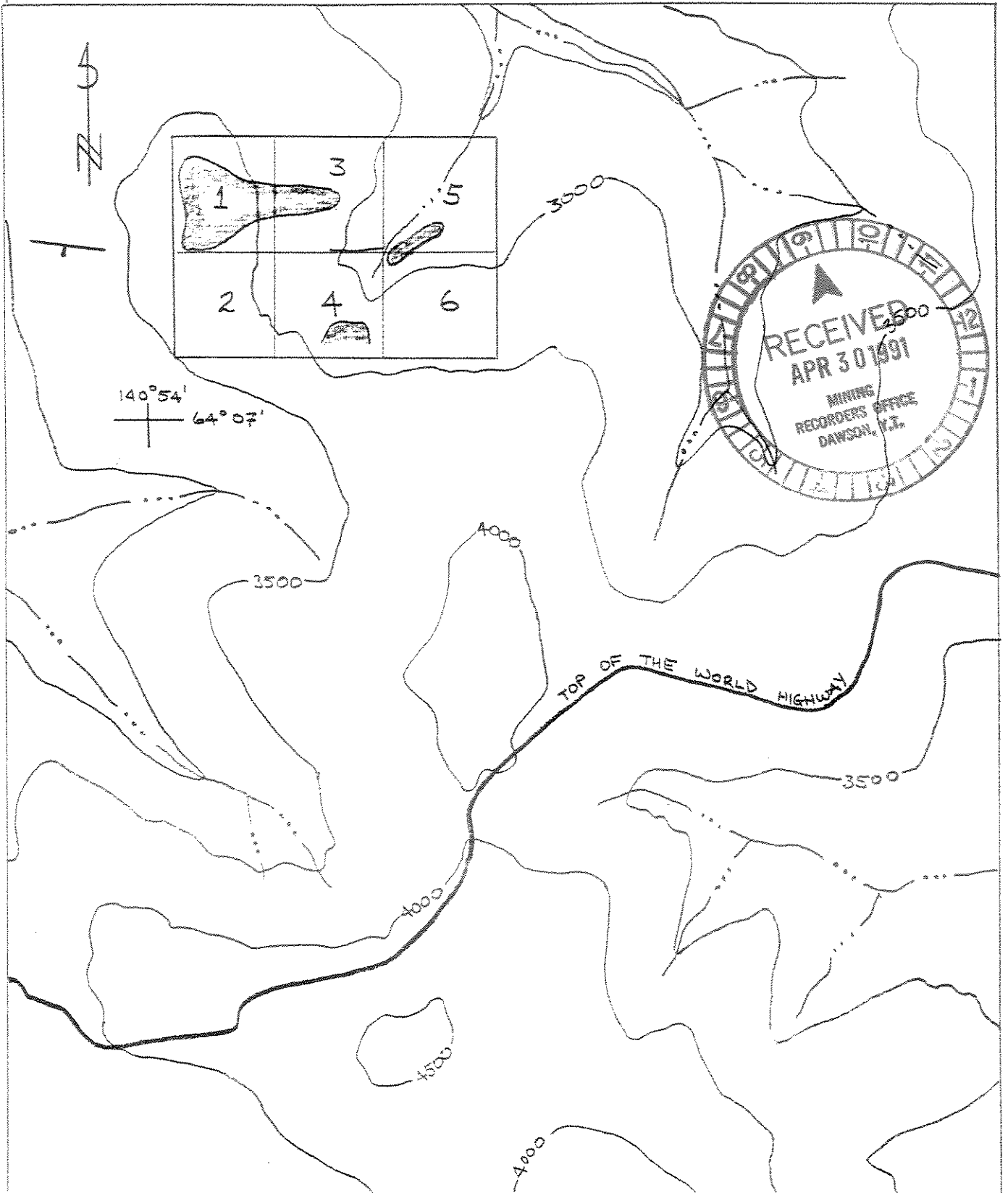
