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SUMMARY

The Simpson property consists of 235 mineral claims staked under the Yukon Quartz Mining Act in the Watson Lake Mining District. The property is 20 kilometres west of the Robert Campbell Highway and approximately 90 kilometres northwest of the community of Watson Lake by air. The property is underlain by Late Devonian to Mississippian rocks of middle unit of the Layered Metamorphic Sequence which hosts polymetallic volcanogenic massive sulphide deposits recently discovered at Kudz Ze Kayah and Wolverine Lake. The property was staked to cover occurrences of stratiform copper-zinc-lead-silver mineralization discovered during follow-up of government lake sediment multi-element geochemical anomalies. A series of silt sediment geochemical anomalies, mineralized bedded barite float occurrences and stratiform sulphide mineralization occurrences define an open-ended trend at least 1.6 kilometres long. Two significant sulphide occurrences are located along this trend. The RFG showing contains two mineralized horizons in a partly covered, 30 m thick section of quartz-muscovite schist and argillite. Selected mineral specimens from this showing returned values of up to 2.17% copper, 10.50% lead, 2.26% zinc and 128.6 g/t silver. The BW showing is 300 m east of the RFG showing along the mineralized trend and returned values of up to 1.57% copper, 2.22% lead, 0.95% zinc, 185 g/t silver and 160 ppb gold from rocks with similar mineralization. A multi-component helicopter electromagnetic and magnetic field survey was conducted in February 1996 to further evaluate the showings on the property. The survey identified a 30 to 50 nT positive total magnetic field anomaly parallel to and locally coincident with the prospective horizon. One electromagnetic anomaly with an indicated conductance of 10 to 20 Seimens and coincident positive magnetic response occurs 400 m southeast of the BW showing. A two-stage drilling program is recommended involving 1500 feet in the first phase and 3000 feet in a second phase, contingent upon the results of the first. A project budget of \$450,000 is appended to this report.

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Simpson property in the Watson Lake Mining District, Yukon Territory, consists of 235 mineral claims held by Archer, Cathro & Associates (1981) Limited. in trust for Nordac Resources Ltd. The property covers a series of mineral showings with associated geochemical and geophysical anomalies in favourable stratigraphy of the Finlayson Allochthon in the southeastern Yukon Territory.

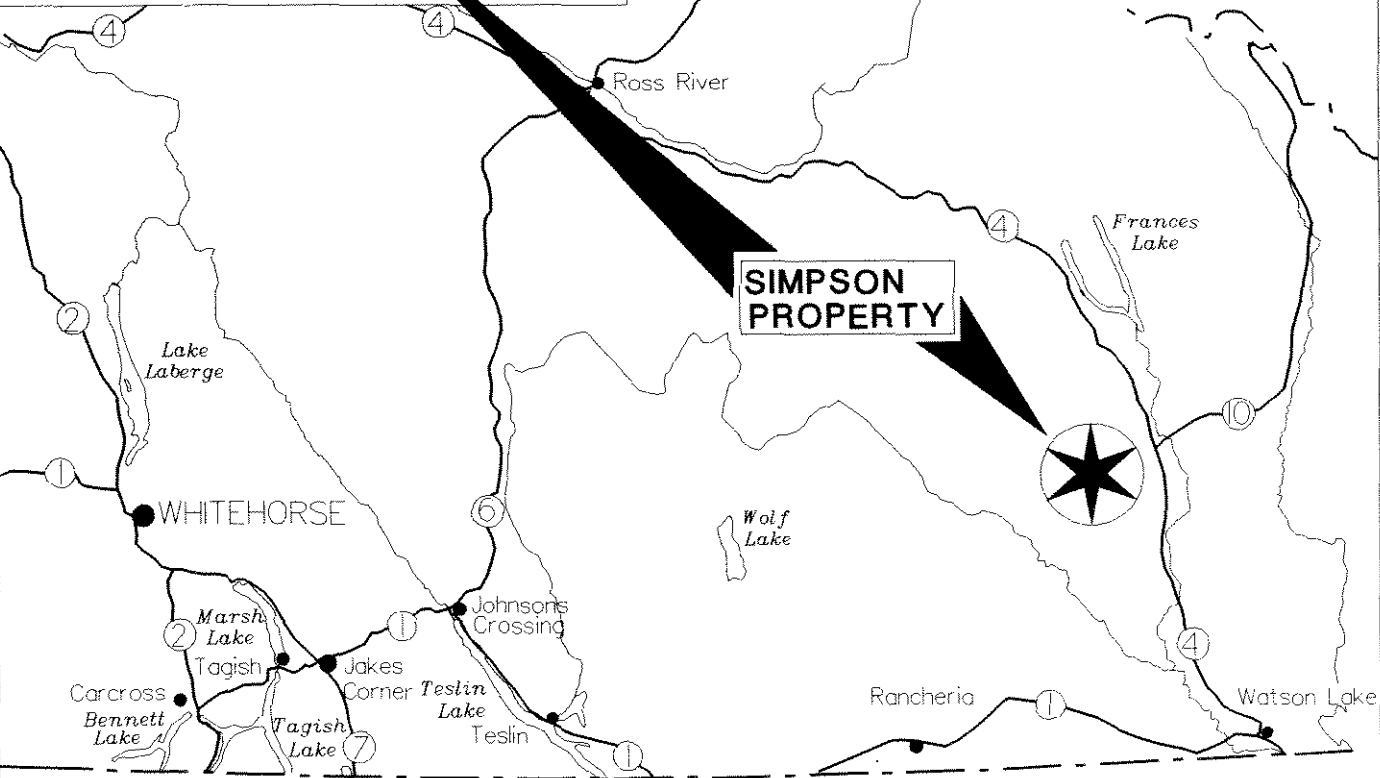
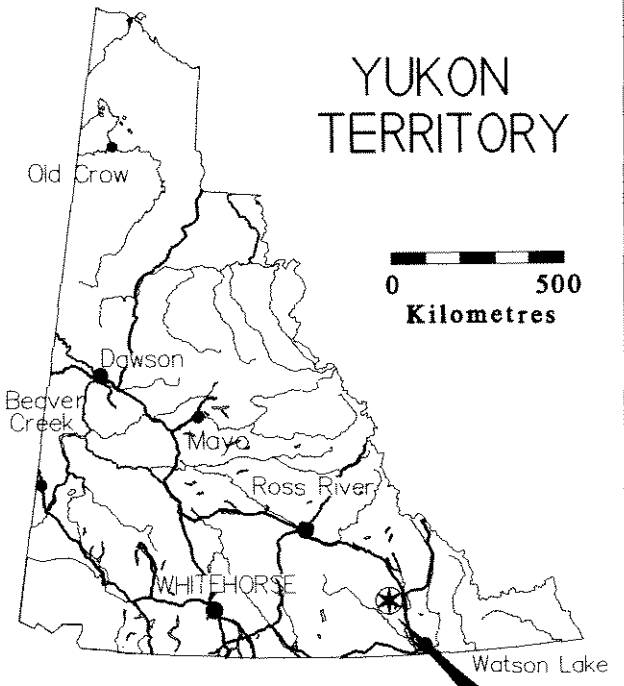
Nordac Resources Ltd. retained Amerok Geosciences Ltd. to assess geological, geochemical and geophysical surveys conducted on the Simpson property and to recommend a staged work program to test the potential of the property. This report is based on published and private reports and maps provided by Archer, Cathro & Associates (1981) Limited. The author has personally conducted or supervised exploration programs on several properties in the Finlayson Allochthon and is familiar with the general area described in this report, but he has not personally visited the property.

2.0 LOCATION AND ACCESS

The Simpson property is centred at 60° 46' N 129° 36' W in southern Yukon Territory on NTS map sheets 105 A 12 and 13 (Figure 1). The property is approximately 90 kilometres north of Watson Lake by air and 20 kilometres west of Kilometre 85 on the Robert Campbell Highway. The property is inaccessible by road although a tote trail extends from the Tuchitua River bridge on the Robert Campbell Highway to Little Jimmy Lake, approximately 15 kilometres north of the property. Sambo Lake, on the eastern boundary of the property, is suitable for float- or ski-equipped fixed wing aircraft. Helicopter charter is available year round in Watson Lake.

The D2 property consists of the following full size unsurveyed mineral claims staked under the Yukon Quartz Mining Act in the Watson Lake Mining District:

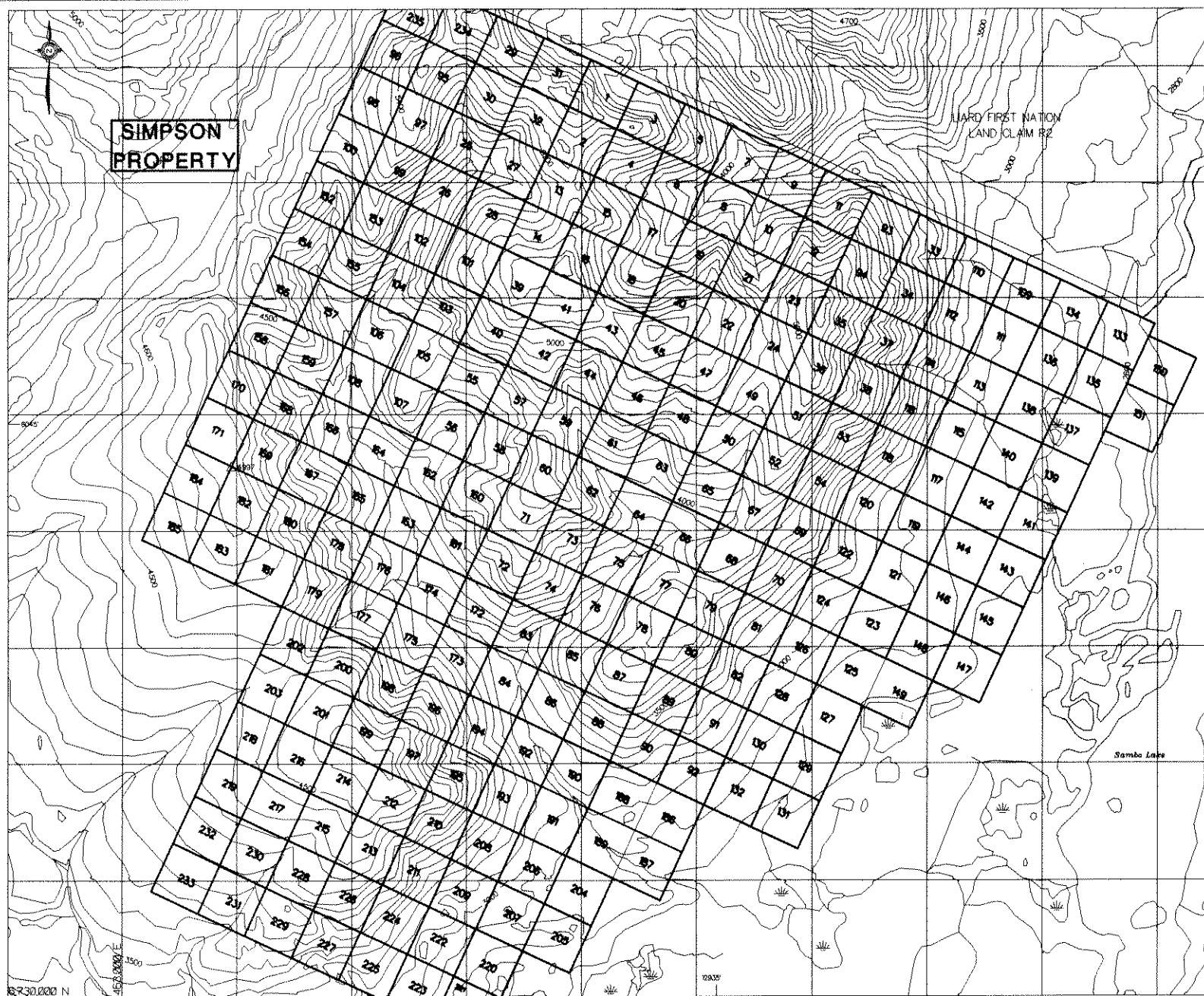

The claim locations are shown together with topography in Figure 2. The property is held in trust for Nordac Resources Ltd. by Archer, Cathro & Associates (1981) Limited.

4.0 PHYSIOGRAPHY

The D2 property is located in the Simpson Range of the Pelly Mountains. Elevations on the property range from 820 m in the southeast corner to almost 1700 m in the northwest corner of the property. The topography is dominated by a sinuous southeast trending ridge flanked by steep cirque walls. Steep slopes are covered with a thin layer of talus while thick glacial till blankets bedrock in the valley floors. Valley bottoms contain mature stands of timber and boggy areas with thick willow and alders while thick stands of spruce occur on higher ground. Tree line occurs at about 1500 m.

5.0 REGIONAL GEOLOGY AND MINERAL OCCURRENCES

The D2 property lies in the Finlayson Allochthon, a fault bounded structural block containing rocks of the Yukon-Tanana and Slide Mountain Terranes in the southeast Yukon (Figure 3). The Finlayson Allochthon is 380 km long and up to 60 km wide. It is bounded on the northeast by the Finlayson Lake Fault Zone, a complex series of thrust and high angle faults and on the southwest by the Tintina Fault Zone, a series of transcurrent faults. Approximately 450 km of dextral displacement along the Tintina Fault Zone has been documented by Tempelman-Kluit *et. al.* (1976).

The Yukon-Tanana and Slide Mountain Terranes are composed of island arc and oceanic assemblages of Proterozoic(?) to Late Paleozoic age (Mortensen 1992). In the Finlayson Allochthon, these rocks are imbricated by large scale thrust faults and intruded by Mesozoic igneous rocks. Mortensen and Jilson (1985) defined the following rock units in the Finlayson Allochthon:

Layered Metamorphic Sequence (Pre-Late Devonian - Early Permian) This sequence consists of three map units. The lowermost unit is a series of metasedimentary rocks consisting of quartz-mica \pm garnet schist, micaceous feldspathic quartzite and, near the top, marble and calcareous schist. The middle unit consists of carbonaceous phyllite, siliceous phyllite and quartzite interlayered with abundant mafic and lesser felsic metavolcanic rocks. This unit, dated as Late Devonian to Middle Mississippian, hosts volcanogenic massive sulphide deposits at Kudz Ze Kayah and Wolverine Lake. The uppermost unit consists of white carbonates and quartzite.

Paleozoic Metaplutonic Rocks (Middle-Paleozoic) Three suites of metamorphosed plutonic rocks are found in the Finlayson Allochthon. These include the Simpson Range plutonic suite of quartz monzonite and quartz diorite and units of augen orthogneiss and monzonitic orthogneiss.

Mafic and Ultramafic Rocks (Late Devonian - Early Permian) This unit consists of massive greenstone, chert and mafic to ultramafic plutonic rocks in fault-bounded blocks.

Mesozoic Clastic Rocks (Late Triassic) This unit consists of shale, siltstone and conglomerate containing clasts from the underlying metamorphic and volcanic rocks.

Mesozoic Plutonic Rocks (Early Jurassic and Late Cretaceous) Unmetamorphosed Early Jurassic plutons of mafic to intermediate composition and Late Cretaceous quartz monzonite are included in this unit.

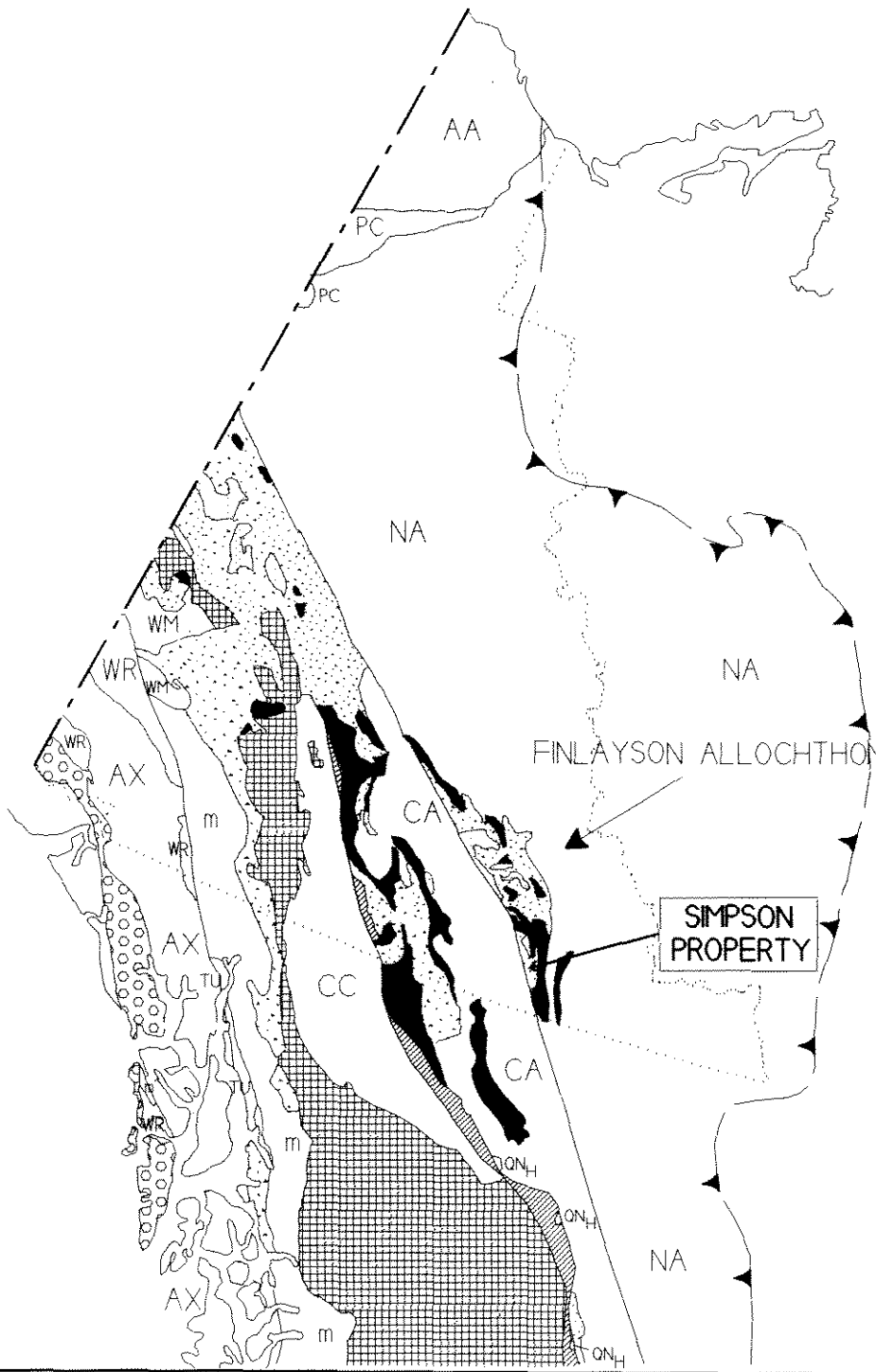

deposit boundaries. This iron formation is reportedly enriched in molybdenum (H. Meade, pers. comm. in Carne 1996, in prep.). Subtle soil geochemical anomalies and a vegetation kill zone underlain by weakly stained malachite schist are found over the projected surface trace of the deposit. The overlying iron formation is an excellent geophysical target but the response of the ore body itself is complicated by graphitic argillite in the surrounding rocks.

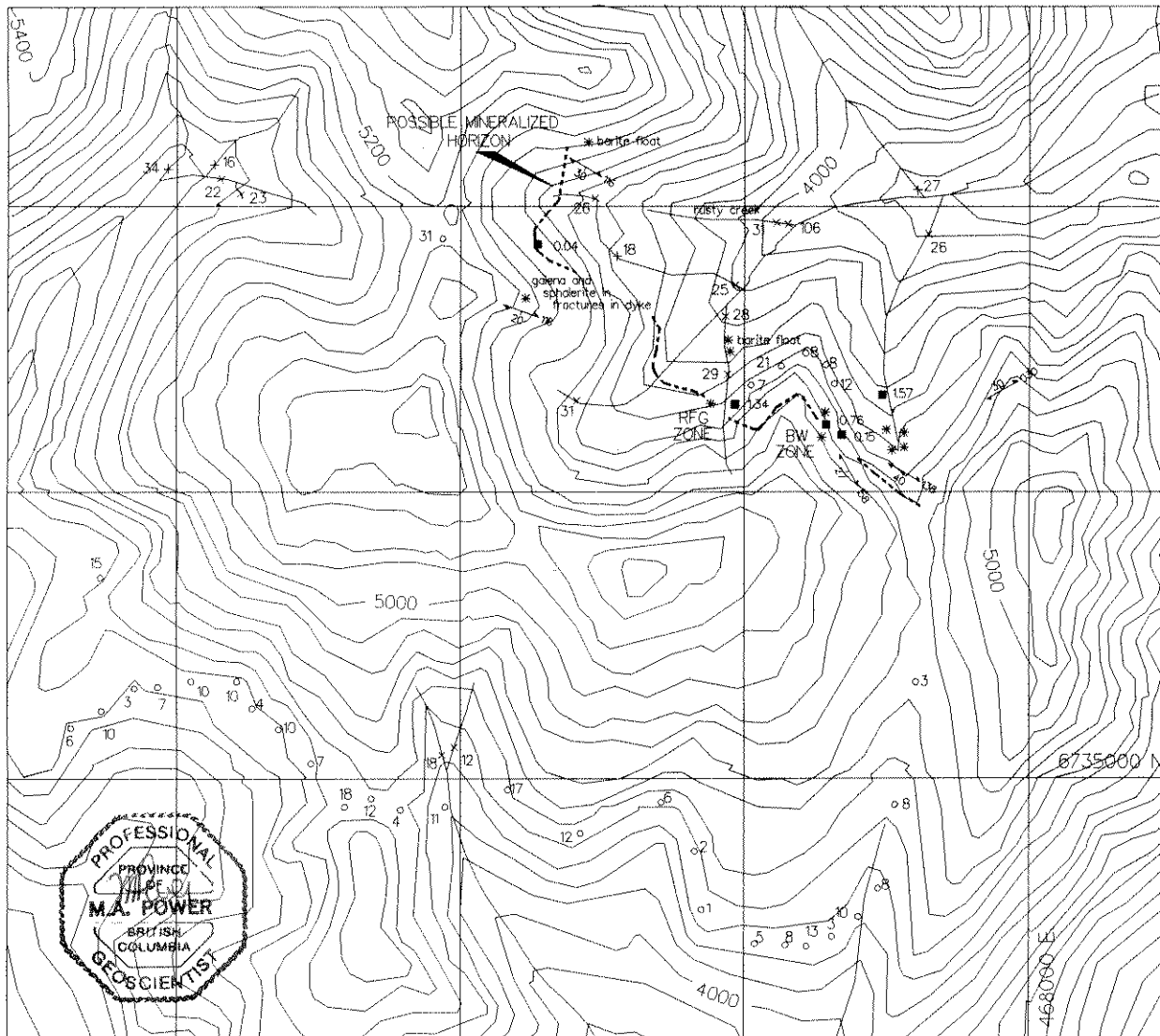
6.0 PROPERTY HISTORY

In 1995, Archer, Cathro & Associates (1981) Limited conducted a regional exploration program for Nordac Resources Ltd. guided by a Geological Survey of Canada lake bottom sediment geochemical survey (Friske *et. al.* 1994). Highly anomalous values in lead and copper (>95 percentile) and anomalous values in silver, barium and zinc (>90 percentile) were recorded in samples from Sambo Lake and similar results were recorded in samples from another nearby lake. The property was staked following the discovery of mineralized float and bedrock during the summer of 1995.

7.0 PROPERTY GEOLOGY, GEOCHEMISTRY AND MINERALIZATION

An exploration program consisting of prospecting, mapping and geochemical sampling was conducted on the Simpson property by geologists with Archer, Cathro & Associates (1981) Limited during July to September 1995 (Carne, 1996, in prep.). The property is underlain by rocks assigned to the middle unit of the Layered Metamorphic Sequence and apparently intruded by Paleozoic Metaplutonic Rocks. On the property, rocks of the Layered Metamorphic Sequence are described as quartz-muscovite and quartz-muscovite-chlorite schist derived respectively from felsic and mafic volcanic protoliths. Composition layering and a parallel, pervasive foliation strike northwest and dip gently southwest. The layered metavolcanic rocks are bounded on the southwest and northeast by shared granitic intrusive and gneissic rocks of the Simpson Range plutonic suite. The nature of the contact between the two rock units is unknown but they are inferred to be in intrusive contact.

Mineralization located to date on the property consists of showings in the headwall of a cirque on claims D2-2,4,16,18 and 20. Geological observations, sample locations and geochemical survey results are shown in Figures 4 to 6. Bedded barite float occurs along a 1.6 km long trend labelled "possible mineralized horizon" in the figures. Stratiform copper, lead, zinc and silver mineralization in siliceous muscovite schist was located in outcrop at the RFG zone where specimens from a 50 cm interval returned values of up to 2.17% copper, 10.50% lead, 2.26% zinc and 128.6 g/t silver. The base of this interval was not exposed. A second zone with similar mineralization was mapped in talus; it appears to occur 30 m above the lower zone. The interval

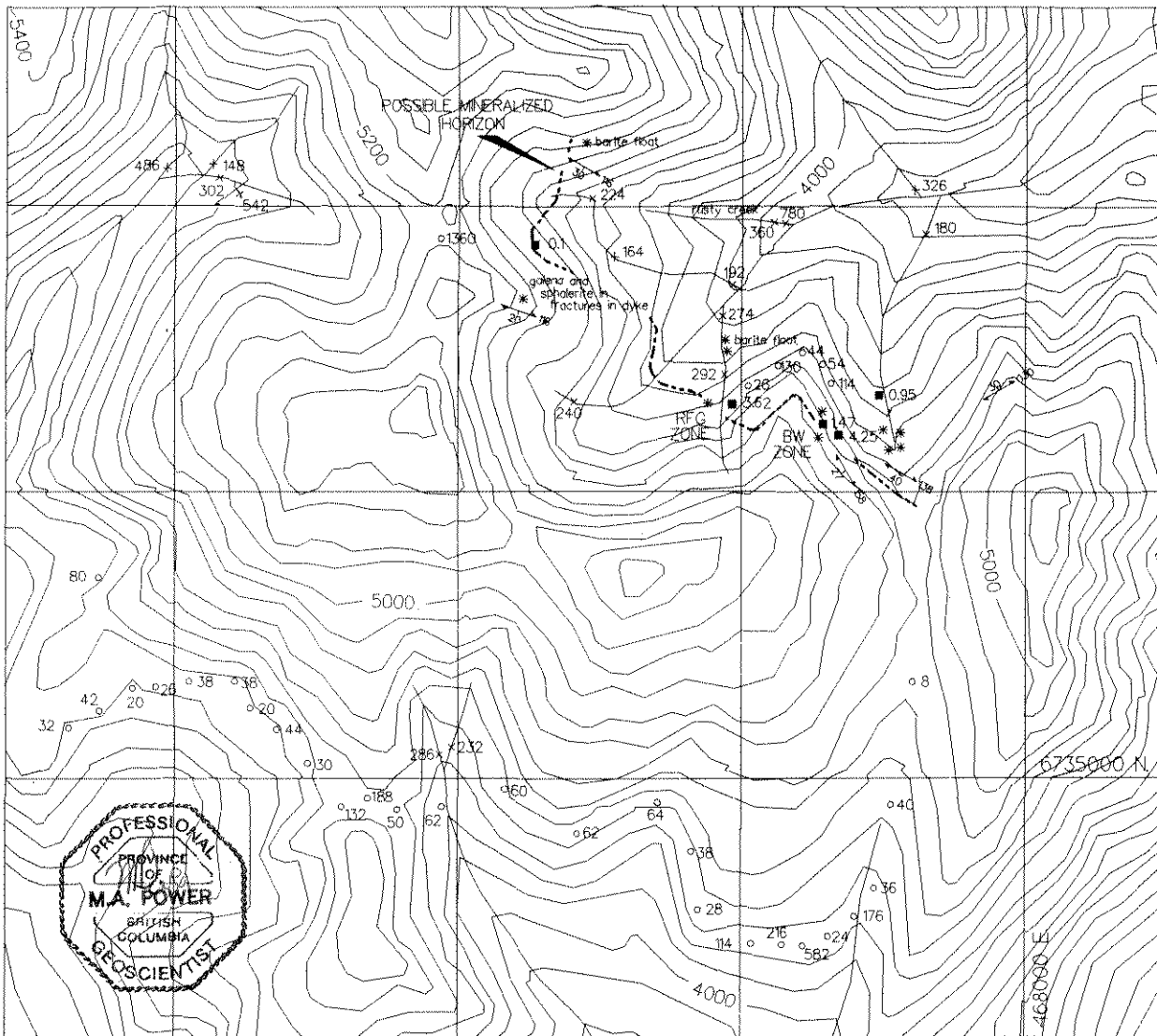

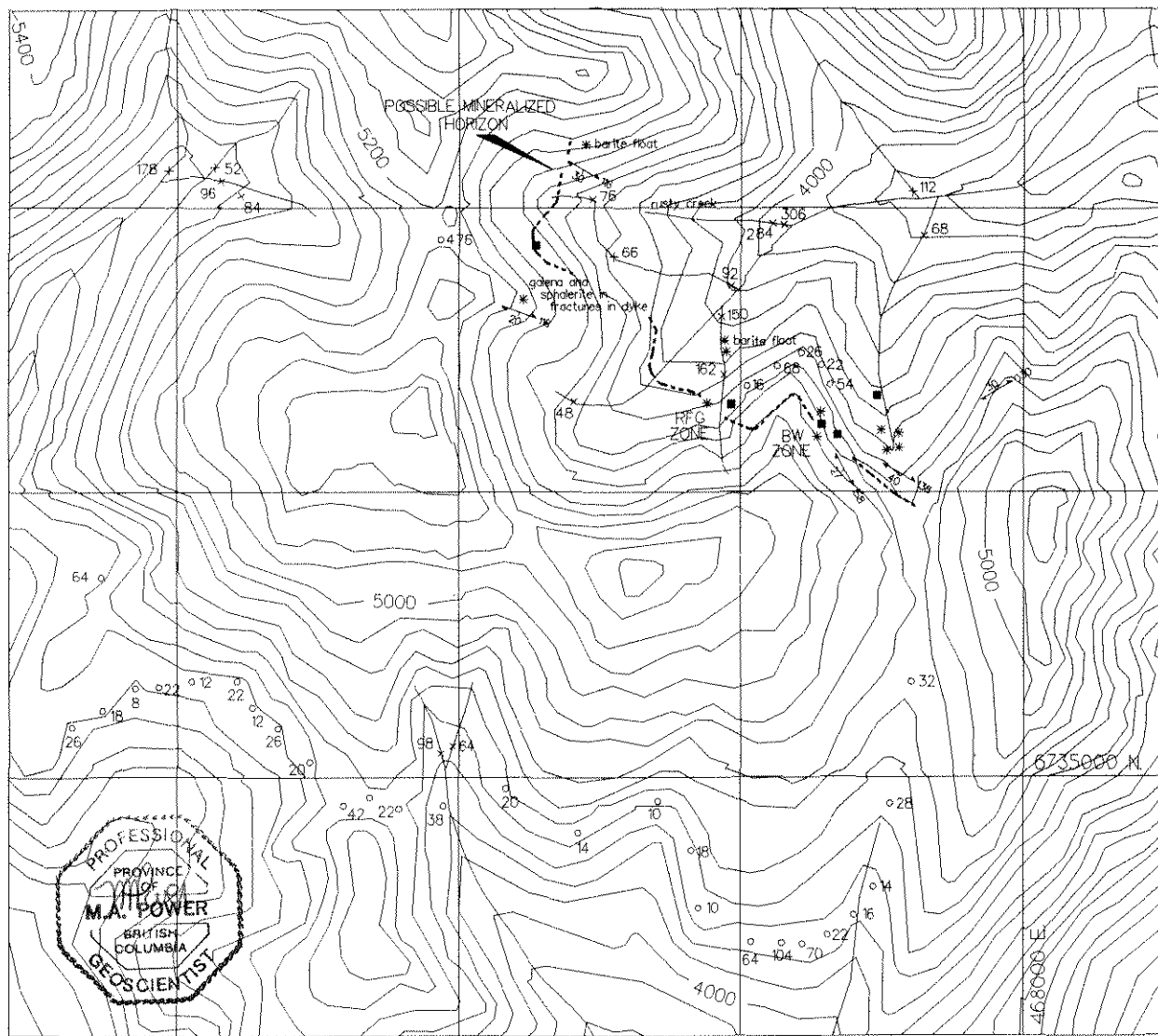

between the two zones is covered. The BW showing is 300 m east of the RFG showing and consists of manganese stained muscovite-chlorite schist in talus with mineralization similar to that in the RFG zone. Assays of this material returned values of up to 1.57% copper, 2.22% lead, 0.95% zinc, 185 g/t silver and 160 ppb gold. The distribution of mineralized float suggests a strike length of around 400 m for this zone. Hand specimen examination revealed extensive boxworks in mineralized samples, probably after zinc and iron sulphides, suggesting significant leaching of zinc. This also may account for the high lead-to-zinc ratios in the assay returns.

Soil and stream sediment geochemical sampling programs were conducted concurrently with the mapping and prospecting program. Soil samples were optimally collected from the B horizon although soil horizons were not sufficiently developed to permit this in many localities. Stream sediment samples were collected from shallow, high gradient streams. Tributaries of creeks draining the main cirque area in which mineralization was discovered contain silts with moderate to strongly anomalous copper, lead and zinc values as well as high silver, barium and cadmium responses. High lead and zinc values were returned from silt samples taken in the cirque west of the main cirque and from soil samples collected on the dip slope south of the showings where the mineralized horizon is projected to subcrop.

The results of the 1995 exploration program indicate that rocks on the property have good potential to host volcanogenic massive sulphide mineralization. The rock units mapped there appear to correlate with those hosting two other massive sulphide deposits in the Finlayson Allochthon. The geochemical survey results suggest that an extensive horizon with elevated values in elements associated with volcanogenic massive sulphide deposits - copper, zinc, lead and silver - exists on the property and that it is roughly coincident with mineralization found in outcrop. Stratiform disseminated copper-lead-zinc-silver sulphide mineralization is found at two localities and stratiform barite is found for a considerable distance along the inferred mineralized trend. Barite is commonly found stratigraphically above or laterally associated with polymetallic volcanogenic massive sulphide deposits in the Kuroko district of Japan, at Rosebery, Tasmania and Madenkoy, Turkey (Franklin *et. al.*, 1981).

8.0 AIRBORNE GEOPHYSICAL SURVEYS

Dighem IPOWER Ltd. was contracted to fly a multi-component helicopter electromagnetic and magnetic field survey over the property. A Dighem V survey covering the entire property was flown in February 1996 using a nominal line spacing of 200 m and bird altitude of 30 m above ground level. Preliminary results indicate that the total magnetic field is quite flat save for a prominent 30 to 50 nT magnetic field high parallel to the general trend indicated as "possible mineralized horizon" in Figures 4 to 6. This magnetic high is coincident with the BW showing and 100 m north of the RFG showing. There were very few discrete electromagnetic conductors identified in the preliminary anomaly maps and only one occurs along the magnetic field high. A discrete anomaly with a conductance of 10 to 20 Seimens occurs 400 m southeast of the BW showing. This conductance falls within the conductance range of most massive sulphide deposits (Palacky 1987) but may also be due to graphite or graphitic argillite.

The association between the magnetic field high, the location of known occurrences and the geochemical anomalies is promising. At both the Kudz Ze Kayah and Wolverine Deposits, economic mineralization is associated with magnetic horizons. At Kudz Ze Kayah, the presence of pyrrhotite and magnetite in the massive sulphide assemblage creates a magnetic field high coincident with part of the deposit. At Wolverine, magnetite rich iron formation lies stratigraphically above the ore deposit and serves as a marker horizon.

The absence of electromagnetic anomalies may indicate that no significant mineralization is present, that any mineralization is non-conductive or that conductive mineralization may be at too great a depth for effective detection by the airborne system. At the RFG and BW zones, mineralized bedrock horizons dip into the steep cirque headwall. Sulphide mineralization located some distance down-dip of these showings may be undetectable by a standard helicopter electromagnetic system.

10.0 CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The work conducted to date on the Simpson property has demonstrated the following:

- a. The stratigraphy mapped on the property and on a regional scale indicates that the property is underlain by the Late Devonian - Mississippian middle unit of the Layered Metamorphic Sequence in the Finlayson Allochthon. This rock unit hosts the recent polymetallic massive sulphide discoveries at Wolverine and Kudz Ze Kayah.
- b. A 1.6 kilometre long trend of anomalous multi-element geochemical responses and bedded barite float occurs in the headwall of the main cirque. Stratiform layers of heavily disseminated sulphides carrying copper, lead, zinc and silver are found in two showings along this trend. The mineralized trend is conformable with compositional layering and may host volcanogenic massive sulphide mineralization.
- c. Geophysical surveys outlined a weak magnetic field high parallel to, and locally coincident with the mineralized trend. One significant electromagnetic response, 400 m southeast of the BW showing, occurs along the magnetic field high.

Electromagnetic surveys capable of deep penetration are necessary to locate drill targets in the mineralized horizon; this work is already planned for 1996. To test the two targets identified to date, a two-stage drill program is recommended. The first phase would require 1500 feet of diamond drilling and the second stage, if warranted by the results of the first program, would involve an additional 3000 feet of diamond drilling. Proposed budgets for these programs are attached as Appendix B.
