**Invasive Species:**


- To minimize the risk and consequences of spreading invasive plant species the proponent should become familiar with the Yukon invasive species and how to manage them by referring to the Yukon Invasive Species Council document, "Why Should I Care About Invasive Species" ([http://yukoninvasives.com/pdf\\_docs/Whyshouldicare2011\\_sm.pdf](http://yukoninvasives.com/pdf_docs/Whyshouldicare2011_sm.pdf))

The proponent should communicate plans and timing of activities to other resource users (trappers, outfitters, wilderness tourism operators (e.g. by contacting the Wilderness Tourism Association of the Yukon).

Please note: the notification will expire on February 21, 2019 and all reclamation must be completed by this date. All proposed activities must abide by Schedule 1 (Operating Conditions) of the *Quartz Mining Land Use Regulation*.
